

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF COUNCIL APPOINTEES ON THE UMP COUNCIL

1. The UMP Council, the highest decision-making body, is responsible for the governance and policy decisions of the University.
2. The UMP Council has two vacancies for external members to serve as Council Appointees.
3. Members of the public, organisations and interest groups are invited to nominate suitable candidates who possess the following knowledge, skills, qualities, and qualifications to serve as Council Appointees on the UMP Council.
4. Specialists are required in **at least one of the following fields**:
 - a. **The Built Environment (e.g. Engineering and/ or Project Management);**
 - b. **Facilities Planning;**
 - c. **Finance;**
 - d. **Governance;**
 - e. **Law.**
5. The candidates must also possess the following generic skills:
 - a. Knowledge and expertise in governance, leadership, compliance management with a reputation for integrity, honesty, and adherence to high ethical standards.
 - b. Possess an ability to exercise sound judgement in matters that relate to the current and long-term objectives of the University and a willingness to contribute positively to the decision-making process of the University.
 - c. Commitment to regularly attend and participate in meetings of the Council and to participate constructively in the deliberations of the Council.
6. Nomination forms are available on the University website www.ump.ac.za, or may be requested from the Office of the Registrar on the email address provided below.
7. Each nomination should be duly signed and accompanied by a recent Curriculum Vitae of the nominee, as well as a brief motivation and SA ID copy.
8. Prior to the appointment, candidates will be subjected to a probity check. By accepting the nomination, a candidate gives consent that the probity check be conducted.
