1. TERMS OF PAYMENT

A student is personally liable for paying their student fees, whether or not the student is funded or not. Should the students be funded or financed by means of a bursary or loan, the student's account must be presented without delay to the person or entity responsible for settling the fees.

A student who is duly registered is liable for the full year's tuition, accommodation, meals and other fees. Where a student deregisters within a specified period, the student will be charged in terms of the University's de-registration rules.

Since a student's fee account is based on his/her registration and accommodation choices, it is their responsibility to verify the correctness of this information.

1.1 Terms of payment for local students (Tuition Fees)

- a. The initial payment for tuition fees (first instalment) is determined annually by Council and is payable by all students on or before registration.
- b. Students with confirmed funding are not required to pay the initial payment.
- c. The balance is payable in 3 equal instalments on or before 30 April, 31 July, and 30 September of each year
- d. Where a student only registers for the second semester in any academic year, then that student is required to pay the maximum of half of the initial instalment of the total of the fees, as determined annually by Council before the student can register, and the balance of the fees by 30 September of that year.

1.2 Terms of payment for local students (Accommodation Fees)

- e. The initial payment (first instalment) for accommodation as determined annually by Council is payable by all students on or before registration, acceptance and allocation into on-campus residence.
- f. Students with confirmed funding for accommodation are not required to pay the initial payment for on-campus accommodation.
- g. The balance of the cost is payable in two equal instalments payable on or before 30 April, and before the closing of the first semester of each year.
- h. Where a student is accepted and allocated on-campus accommodation in the second semester, then the full amount of the accommodation is payable at acceptance and allocation of on-campus accommodation.
- i. All payments received from the funder or student will be allocated to accommodation

1.3 Terms of payment for international students

- j. International students must pay 100% of the prior year's debt and 50% of the current year's tuition and accommodation fees to be cleared for registration for the current year.

1.4 Payment allocation and student debt

- k. All payments received from the funder or student will be allocated to tuition and accommodation fees in proportion to balances owed for tuition and accommodation fees before the payment was received.
- l. An Acknowledgement of Debt (AOD) cannot be signed in the year unless a student has complied with the payment plan of the previous year's AOD.
- m. A student will not be allocated on-campus accommodation in the current year, unless the previous year's fee balance has been paid in full.
- n. Terms and conditions of repayment of student debt for financial clearance in the current year.

If the prior year's debt is:	The student is required to pay:
Below R10 000	The full outstanding amount
Above R10 000 but below R30 000	R10 000 plus 15% of the amount above R10 000 but below R30 000
Above R30 000 but below R50 000	R13 000 plus 20% of the amount above R30 000 but below R50 000
Above R50 000 but below R100 000	R17 000 plus 20% of the amount above R50 000 but below R100 000
Above R100 000	R29 500 plus 30% above R100 000

1.5 Cancellation of studies/accommodation

- o. A student cancelling their registration of modules or programmes /accommodation must advise the University in writing and complete the relevant form. Such notice must be submitted to the relevant Faculty Administration Office and/or Residence Office before leaving the University.
- p. All outstanding fees must be paid immediately upon discontinuation of studies or residence.
- q. The financial liability of a student is determined by the date on which notice of cancellation is received by the University, see the tables below.

Tuition Fees

Date on which notification is received (first semester):	Financial liability (amount payable):
Cancelled by the end of February	No levy/fee
Cancelled by the end of March	50% of tuition fee
Cancelled from the 1 st of April	100% of tuition fee (no discount granted)

Date on which notification is received (second semester):	Financial liability (amount payable):
Cancelled by the end of July	No levy/fee
Cancelled by the end of August	50% of tuition fee
Cancelled from the 1 st of September	100% of tuition fee (no discount granted)

1.6 Method of payment

Students must use their identification (ID) number as a reference when paying for application fees. When making payment for registration, tuition, and residence fees, students must use their 9-digit student number provided by the University upon application.

- Credit card payment can be made through the University's online Paygate option on iEnabler. **Application fees** are paid during the application process. An option such as below will be seen in the application wizard:



Students should **allow at least 48 hours for payment** to be received by UMP's bank account before requesting clearance. Clearance will only be given when payment has been received, and the correct reference is used.

2. FEE STRUCTURE

The Council of the University approves tuition, accommodation, meals, and other applicable fees annually.

2.1 Application fees

A non-refundable application fee, as indicated on the application form, must accompany each application. The following application fees are applicable for the 2026 academic year.

2.2 Initial payment (first instalment)

The initial payment for tuition and accommodation, as approved annually by the Council, is due by all students on or before the registration date. Students with confirmed funding are not required to pay the initial payment.
